Compared to last Thursday, not enough stocker or feeder cattle this week for accurate trends. Feeder cattle futures are trading with 67 cent to \$2.15 losses in the front months on Thursday. The CME Feeder Cattle Index was back up 53 cents to \$374.36 on February 10. Slaughter cows 3.00-6.00 higher. Slaughter bulls 7.00-13.00 higher. Trade active with good demand. Supply included: 14% Feeder Cattle (24% Heifers, 13% Bulls, 62% Dairy Heifers); 77% Slaughter Cattle (10% Cows, 2% Bulls, 88% Dairy Cows); 9% Replacement Cattle (31% Bred Cows, 69% Bred Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 40%.
