Compared to last week: Feeder steers traded 6.00 to 7.00 higher. Not enough comparable sales on heifers for a market trend, but a higher undertone was noted. Buyer demand was good. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (60.5% Steers, 39.5% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 100%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 2% shrink or equivalent, with a 8-12 cent slide >600 lbs. and 15-20 cent slide < 600 lbs. Livestock reported this week originated from NM.
