Compared to last week: Not enough trades to truly test the market. Demand good. Markets on a roller coaster this week but coming in strong today as fundamentally lighter numbers continue to rule. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (37.7% Steers, 62.3% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 100%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 2% shrink or equivalent, with an 8-12 cent slide > 600 lbs. Livestock reported this week originated from MO.
