Compared to last week, a few comparable sales were 30.00 lower. Trade and demand moderate. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (6.9% Steers, 89.8% Dairy Steers, 3.3% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 10%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 2-3% shrink or equivalent, with a 5-10 cent slide on calves, 3-6 cent slide on yearlings. Delivered prices included freight, commissions, and other expenses. Livestock reported this week originated from AZ, MO.
