Compared to last week, feeders have no comparison. Trade moderate, demand good. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (15.8% Steers, 68.3% Dairy Steers, 15.8% Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 31%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 2-3% shrink or equivalent, with a 5-10 cent slide on calves, 3-6 cent slide on yearlings. Delivered prices included freight, commissions, and other expenses. Livestock reported this week originated from CA, ID, TX.
