With the increase in the CME feeder cattle boards some buyers are thinking of trying to lock up some grass cattle for fall deliver. Base weight and delivery month is the real questions as the grazing areas are very dry and short grass prevails in a large area. Nebraska feedlot trade remains at a standstill as of noon on Friday. With the CME live April cattle board banging around the 250.00 mark, feedlots would really like to have that price to move their show-list. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 100%. Unless otherwise noted, Feeder Cattle prices FOB based on net weights after a 1-2% shrink or equivalent, with up to 15 cent slide > 600 lbs. Livestock reported this week originated from NE.
